Danxu, a student from China, was with us for some days over Christmas 2015. She participated in FOCUS and other events, and when her parents came for her graduation the next summer, we hosted them for a barbecue. (Her dad felt the leaves on our maple tree and couldn't believe how clean they were!) That summer she moved to Florida to continue her studies and a few years went by since our last communication. Allan is a Korean graduate who calls Mary "Mom. He asked for help writing out his statement of faith (testimony) as he applied to work in the Catholic schools. Apparently that didn't work out because on Saturday he told her he has a job as an EA at a Christian school in BC! Allan trusted Jesus while he was at Fanshawe College and has now asked us to arrange for his baptism because, having moved back to London during the pandemic, he's not part of a physical church.

"When I don't see you for awhile, I feel homesick!" a student who just graduated told Stuart on Friday. He is an only child, raised by a single dad in Calcutta, India. When we first met him last June, S told us that he felt like he had met his Canadian family. We have connected numerous times and come to love this young man. He called and sang to both of us on our birthdays saying, "I am your son, too!" Because everyone mispronounces his name (we finally got it right!), his dad told him that he gave him his Indian name, so Stuart & Mary, his Canadian parents, should give him an English name. What an honour! He was more than a little happy when on Victoria Day we presented him with a Certificate of English Name and took him to meet Mary's mom. He doesn't have any grandparents and said later that he really wanted to hug Granny! Maybe next time!

We wanted a name that started with the same sound as his Indian name and had a special meaning. Meet Shawn which means "God is gracious" or "Gift from God". When he shared this with his dad in India, Shawn said he had tears in his eyes. Please pray for Shawn: - that an interview this week leads to a job

Our speaker was sick and it seemed that every day just in our normal conversations with people we knew, we heard of 3 or 4 more households that were sick. God willing we can have a picnic on the August long weekend and resume FOCUS in September as classes are scheduled to be back in person in September. Thanks for partnering with us. Jesus said, "The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few! Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field." (Lk 10:2NLT) Will you join us in that prayer?
