- 1. At Pentecost the Gospel Became Central – v:1
- 2. At Pentecost God's Presence became unmistakable – vv:2-3
- 3. At Pentecost God's Spirit Became Personal – v:4



The Gift of Tongues

- 1. They are a Gift
- 2. They are unknown to the speaker
- 3. They require an interpreter



Some Cautions

- 1. The meaning is debated and uncertain
- 2. They are optional
- 3. Paul prefers NORMAL speech
- 4. Prefer Prophecy over Tongues
- 5. They are highly subjective
- 6. They are risky
- 7. Different Culture from Biblical Culture
