


**Jesus: Led Like a Lamb to

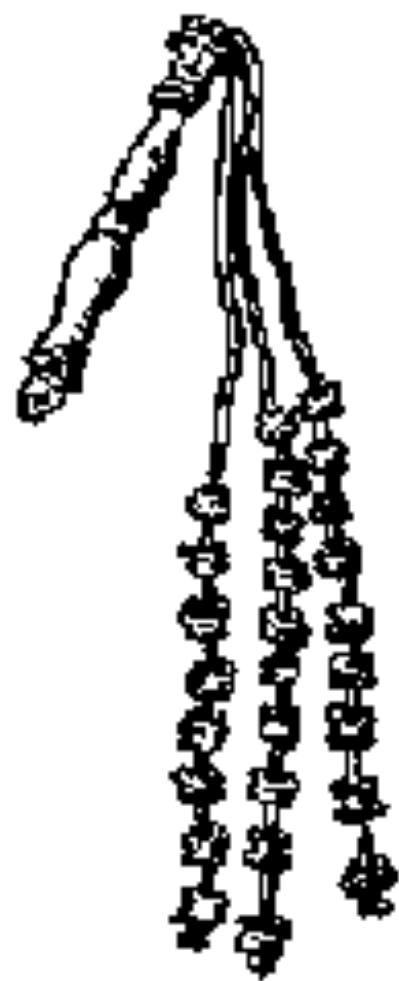
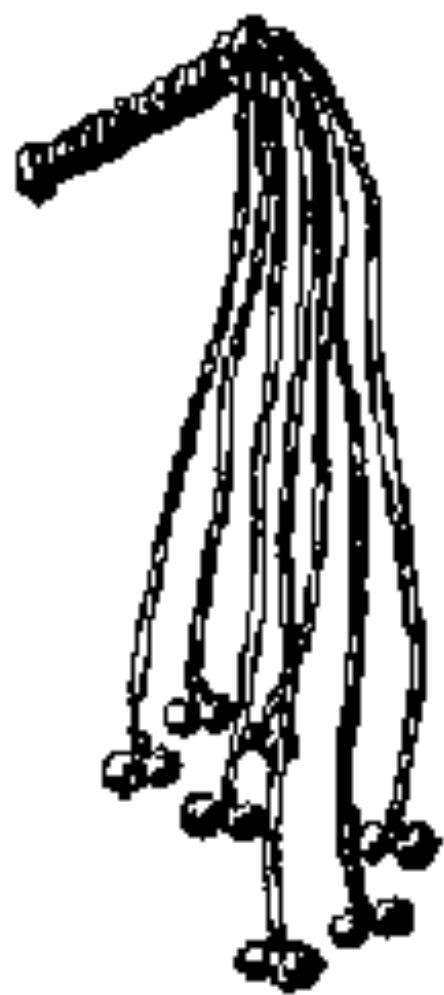

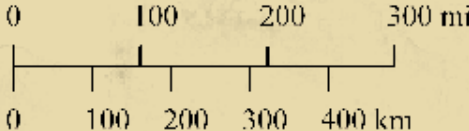
