1 Corinthians 1:1-3

**Hebrews 11:13** “All these people were still living by faith when they died. They did not receive the things promised; they only saw them and welcomed them from a distance. And they admitted that they were aliens and strangers on earth.”

**1 Peter 2:11** “Dear friends, I urge you, as aliens and strangers in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against your soul”

## 1. I need to think accurately about **MYSELF** - 1:1 (Exemplified in Paul)

- God has a PLAN for me – I am SIGNIFICANT
  - Called implies relationship and task
  - Apostle – Delegate, Messenger, sent one on mission

Paul states ... **I know who I am; I know whose I am; I know where I am going.**
- It's about God's WILL not mine – I am SURRENDERED
  - **Devoted to His will above my own**
  - **God is ultimate appraiser of my life and ministry**
  - **He calls the shots in all we do**
- I'm part of TEAM - I am SOLIDLY CONNECTED
  - Paul had others ... He was not a soloist
  - Sosthenes – Probably was scribe for Paul writing 1 Corinthians
  - **World stresses independence.**
  - **Church - key is interdependence. (1 Cor. 12)**

Like it or not in the worlds eyes you are the deviation ... but in God's eyes you are beautiful.
